

 policy coordination
- Indirect influence on FTA outcomes

- Mechanisms for dialogue at governance level
- Expert international collaboration platforms:
 e.g. IPEEC, IEA, UN Environment
- Possible ways forward:
 - Working groups
 - Institutional rapprochement with WTO
 - Institutional space of FTAs, e.g. CETA Regulatory
 Cooperation Forum
